MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE.—SAML DODSWORTH BOOK CO., LEAVENWORTH, KAN. No. 19789.

THIS INDENTURE, Made this 14th day of April, A. D. 1910, between Lee Cole and Maud Cole, his wife of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and J. M. Wakefield of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of Fifty-three and 33/100 Dollars (\$ 53.33), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, the following-described Real Estate, situated in Tulsa County, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Three (3) in Block Eight (8) Wakefield Addition to the City of Tulsa, according to the recorded plat thereof DOLLARS,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED, ALWAYS, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas said Lee Cole and Maud Cole, his wife have this day executed and delivered 3 certain promissory notes in writing to said party of the second part, described as follows:

One note for \$ 17.78 due in six months
One note for \$ 17.78 due in one year
One note for \$ 17.77 due in eighteen months

All notes bearing interest at the rate of eight per cent per annum from date until paid.

Now, if said party of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said party of the second part his heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above-described notes mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then this mortgage shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, the whole of said sum or sums, and interest thereon, shall then become due and payable, and said party of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises. And the said party of the first part for said consideration do hereby expressly waive an appraisement of said real estate and all benefit of the homestead exemption and stay laws of the State of Oklahoma.
