MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE.—SAML. DODSWORTH BOOK CO., LEAVENWORTH, KAN. No. 19788.

THIS INSTRUMENT, Made this 14th day of April, A. D. 1912, between E. E. Jones and Shirley M. Jones, his wife of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and J. M. Wakefield of Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the second part:

WITNESSETH, That said part of the first part, in consideration of Seventy and no/100 Dollars (\$70.00), the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part of the second part his heirs and assigns, the following-described Real Estate, situated in Tulsa County, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots Eight (8) and Nine (9) Blocks Ten (10) Wakefield Addition to the City of Tulsa, as per recorded plat thereof DOLLARS,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME unto the said part of the second part his heirs and assigns, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in anywise appertaining, forever.

PROVIDED, ALWAYS, And these presents are upon this express condition, that whereas said E. E. Jones & Shirley M. Jones, his wife have this day executed and delivered 3 certain promissory notes in writing to said part of the second part, described as follows:

One note for \$23.34 due six months from date.
One note for \$23.33 due one year from date.
One note for \$23.33 due eighteen months from date.
All notes bearing interest at the rate of eight per cent per annum from date.

Now, if said part of the first part shall pay or cause to be paid to said part of the second part his heirs or assigns, said sum of money in the above-described notes mentioned, together with the interest thereon, according to the terms and tenor of the same, then this mortgage shall be wholly discharged and void; and otherwise shall remain in full force and effect. But if said sum or sums of money or any part thereof, or any interest thereon, is not paid when the same is due, and if the taxes and assessments of every nature which are or may be assessed and levied against said premises or any part thereof are not paid when the same are by law made due and payable, the whole of said sum or sums, and interest thereon, shall then become due and payable, and said part of the second part shall be entitled to the possession of said premises. And the said part of the first part for said consideration do hereby expressly waive an appraisalment of said real estate and all benefit of the homestead exemption and stay laws of the State of Oklahoma.
