R.) and south half (S 1/2) of south half (S 1/2) of southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of northwest quarter (NW 1/4) of sec. thirty two (32) town. nineteen (19), R. twelve (12) allotment of U. La. ah. con-tay-na, Ch. 8848

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.
