THIS INDENTURE, Made this 12th day of April, A.D. 1909, between
W.F. Tucker and Georgia B. Tucker, his wife, of
Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and
C. Ferguson, of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma,
of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That said part 1/2 of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Twenty five hundred and no Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part 1/2 of the second part, heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: Part of Lots One (1) and two (2) in Block sixtysix (66) in the city of Tulsa, more particularly described as part of said lots bounded as follows: Beginning at the point of intersection of the easterly line by the alley in said block 66 with the southerly line of the right of way of the St. Louis & San Francisco Railroad Company, thence in a southerly direction along the said easterly line of the said alley to a point of intersection with the northerly line of First street, thence in an easterly direction along such northerly line of first street a distance of sixty (60) feet to a point, thence in a northerly direction in a line parallel with the easterly line of the aforesaid alley to a point of intersection with the southerly line of the right of way of the St. Louis & San Francisco Railroad Company, thence in a westerly direction along such southerly line of such right of way to point of beginning, according to the official Plat of the City of Tulsa, Oklahoma.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said W.F. Tucker & Georgia B. Tucker for themselves their for heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 1/2 of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever, except special assessments for street improvement, paving and sidewalks, which grantee is to pay, and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said part 1/2 of the second part, the heirs and assigns, against said part 1/2 of the first part, theirs, heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same. except special assessments for street improvement, paving and sidewalks, grantor is to pay general taxes for 1908, granted to pay taxes for 1909 and subsequent years.
