THIS INDENTURE, Made this 29 day of April, A.D. 1919, between A. B. Owens and Octavia Owens, husband and wife, of Tulsa, Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and J. H. Masters, of Tulsa, Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, of the second part.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three Thousand and _____ Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do _____ by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The undivided one fifth (1/5) interest in and to the West one hundred and fifteen (115) feet off of Lot Five (5) in Block one hundred and six (106) in the city of Tulsa according to the approved plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said A. B. Owens and Octavia Owens for their heirs, executors or administrators, do _____ hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; and do hereby release the 1/2 of two mortgages amounting to \$4500 which are held against the property herein granted and the 1/2 of the 1908 tax which was granted against the property herein granted and that they will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, against said parties of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
