WITNESSETH, The said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty (\$150.00) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do \_\_\_\_\_ by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part 2d of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All of the northwest quarter (1/4) of section fourteen (14) in township sixteen (16) north and range thirteen (13) east of the Indian Meridian, containing one hundred sixty (160) acres more or less as the case may be according to the U.S. Gov't survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.
