Warranty Deed

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we B. K. Pettus and Frankie C. Pettus
his wife; for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen and Twenty five DOLLARS;
to them in hand paid by E. Uhrig, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby ~~begin~~ ^{renew} grant, sell and convey unto the said E. Uhrig
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Tulsa,
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lot Three (3) Block One hundred eighty nine (189), Town of Tulsa, Creek Nation,
Western District, Indian Territory, according to the official plat of said town.

To have and to hold the same unto the said E. Uhrig and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said E. Uhrig that they
will forever warrant and defend the title to said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Frankie C. Pettus wife of the said B. K. Pettus
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said E. Uhrig
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
