## Warranty Deed

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

## Know All Men By These Presents:

That we E. Uhrig and Ella A. Uhrig  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred & fifty (\$750.00) DOLLARS,  
in hand paid by John Cline, receipt of which is herewith acknowledged

do hereby ~~grant~~ <sup>begin</sup> grant, sell and convey unto the said John Cline  
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa,  
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

South one half of Lot three (3) Block one hundred & eighty nine (189) and according to the  
official plat of the original Town site of the City of Tulsa, Indian Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said John Cline and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said John Cline that they  
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Ella A. Uhrig wife of the said E. Uhrig  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said John Cline  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
