WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we I George Fields and (single person)
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve hundred DOLLARS,

do hereby ~~grant~~ ^{relinquish} grant, sell and convey unto the said Edward Crowell & Legus L. Perryman
 and unto Their heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Sevier Nation
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 Sec. 6, Township 18th and Range 13^E Containing forty acres more or less
as per U.S. survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Crowell & Perryman and unto Their heirs
 and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Crowell & Perryman that He
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
 all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
