## Know All Men By These Presents:

That we I George Fields a single man of Muskogee Creek Nation, Indian Territory  
for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,  
to him paid by Thomas J. Crowell receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby bargain, grant, sell and convey unto the said Thomas J. Crowell  
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the described lot or parcel of ground, lying and being situated in the  
Creek Nation,  
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of my undivided right title and interest in and to the south half of the south west quarter of section  
six (6) and the west half of the south west quarter of section five (5) all of Township eighteen (18) north  
Range thirteen (13) east, as heir at law of Nellie Fields, my deceased sister

To have and to hold the same unto the said Thomas J. Crowell and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
