WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we William E. Rohde and Mary E. Rohde
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One DOLLARS,

Receipt of which is hereby given and acknowledged

do hereby ~~bargain~~ ^{bargain}, grant, sell and convey unto the said J. M. Gillette
 and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Northern

Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Six in Block Twenty four 24 Town of Skiatook, Cherokee Nation Indian Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. M. Gillette and unto his heirs
 and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant S with said J. M. Gillette that He
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mary E. Rohde wife of the said William E. Rohde
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. M. Gillette
 all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
