do hereby ~~grant~~ ^{relinquish}, grant, sell and convey unto the said *J. L. Mitchell*,
 and unto *his* heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the *Creek National*
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

*The North half (1/2) of Lot No. Five (5) in Block No. One hundred twenty-five (125) in the town of Tulsa,
 according to the Official Plat and Survey thereof.*

To have and to hold the same unto the said *J. L. Mitchell* and unto *his* heirs
 and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said *J. L. Mitchell* that *I*
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, ~~the wife of the said~~
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
 all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
