

Warranty Deed

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we S. G. Kennedy and Agnes Kennedy
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars DOLLARS,
to them in hand paid by P. E. Cozue, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged,

do hereby ~~grant~~ ^{convey} grant, sell and convey unto the said P. E. Cozue
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Tulsa
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots Numbered Twelve, Thirteen, Fourteen, Fifteen and Sixteen in Block Numbered Two in the Oaklawn Addition
to Tulsa, D. T., according to the official Plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said P. E. Cozue and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said P. E. Cozue that they
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Agnes Kennedy wife of the said S. G. Kennedy
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said P. E. Cozue
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
