WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

## Know All Men By These Presents:

That we Chas. W. Grimes and Josephine Grimes  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred (\$200.) DOLLARS,  
in hand paid by R. W. Johnson

do hereby ~~bargain~~ <sup>bargain</sup> grant, sell and convey unto the said R. W. Johnson  
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Leek Nation,  
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot numbered four (4) in Block numbered nine (9) in Oakdale Suburb to the town of Shiloh, Indian Territory according to recorded plat thereof, any improvement on said lots are hereby preserved.

To have and to hold the same unto the said R. W. Johnson and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said R. W. Johnson that they  
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Josephine Grimes wife of the said Chas. W. Grimes  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said R. W. Johnson  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
