WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

## Know All Men By These Presents:

That we Levi W. Lindsey and Lila W. Lindsey  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty Two Hundred & Fifty (6250.00) DOLLARS,  
The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and ten in hand paid by J. A. McCullough

do hereby ~~grant~~ <sup>convey</sup> grant, sell and convey unto the said J. A. McCullough  
and unto His heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa  
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Three (3) Block One Hundred and Seven (107) according to the "Official Plat"  
and Government Survey of the said City of Tulsa, Ind. Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. A. McCullough and unto His heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said J. A. McCullough that They  
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lila W. Lindsey wife of the said Levi W. Lindsey  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. A. McCullough  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
