# Warranty Deed

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

## Know All Men By These Presents:

That we Henrietta Haiskey nee Carlisle and Frank C. Haiskey

to me in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged and other good and valuable consideration  
by me had received

do hereby ~~grant~~ <sup>relinquish</sup>, grant, sell and convey unto the said Geo Adams  
 and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the

Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:  
The South Half (S<sup>2</sup>) of the South West Quarter (SW<sup>4</sup>) of the South West Quarter (SW<sup>4</sup>) of Section  
Fifteen (15) Township Twenty (20) North and Range Fourteen (14) East Cherokee Nation, Ind. Terr.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Geo Adams and unto his heirs  
 and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Geo Adams that I  
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Frank C. Haiskey husband ~~wife~~ of the said Henrietta Haiskey nee Carlisle  
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Geo Adams  
 all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
