WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we C. W. Singleton and Bessie Singleton
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred DOLLARS,
In hand paid by Maggie McIntire, receipt of which is hereby
acknowledged and confessed

do hereby ^{grant} bargain, ~~grant~~ sell and convey unto the said Maggie McIntire
 and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the

Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Nine (9) in Block Six (6) in Lindseys Addition to the
City of Tulsa Western District Indian Territory according to
the Plat now on file

To have and to hold the same unto the said Maggie McIntire and unto her heirs
 and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Maggie McIntire that we
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bessie Singleton wife of the said C. W. Singleton
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Maggie McIntire
 all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
