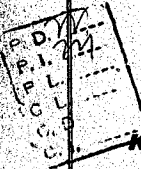

Warranty Deed

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know All Men By These Presents:

That we Rachel M. Chastain ~~and~~ wife of Ed. Chastain the grantee herein
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One and 00/100 (\$1.00) DOLLARS,
in hand paid by Ed. Chastain, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby ~~grant~~ ^{reassign} grant, sell and convey unto the said Ed. Chastain
 and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Beginning at the South Eastern corner of Lot 5, thence running in a westerly direction fifty feet,
thence in a northerly direction One Hundred and fifty feet, thence in an easterly direction fifty feet, thence
in a southerly direction One Hundred and fifty feet to the place of beginning. The North fifty feet being in
Lot Six all in Block Thirty* (30) according to plat and survey of this day, 1906.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Ed. Chastain and unto his heirs
 and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ed. Chastain that
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And ~~by~~ wife of the said

~~all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.~~
