## Warranty Deed

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

## Know All Men By These Presents:

That we W. E. Campbell and Emily M. Campbell  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) DOLLARS,  
to them in hand paid by R. L. Green, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged,

do hereby ~~grant~~ <sup>reassign</sup> grant, sell and convey unto the said R. L. Green  
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Tulsa  
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot numbered Nine (9) in Block numbered Two (2) in the George B. Perryman, Jr.  
addition to the Town of Tulsa, according to the official record of the same,

To have and to hold the same unto the said R. L. Green and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said R. L. Green that they  
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Emily M. Campbell wife of the said W. E. Campbell  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said R. L. Green  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
