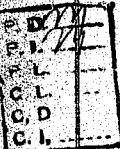

Warranty Deed

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.



Know All Men By These Presents:

That we Mary M. Brewer and J. L. Brewer her husband
~~his wife~~, for and in consideration of the sum of One DOLLARS,
The receipt of which is hereby duly acknowledged,

do hereby ~~grant~~ ^{reassign} grant, sell and convey unto the said Lola Hunt
 and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Town of Tulsa
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South Half of Lot Six (6), Block One Hundred & Eighty Eight (188) as shown by
official plat of said town.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Lola Hunt and unto her heirs
 and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Lola Hunt that they
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, J. L. Brewer husband ~~of~~ of the said Mary M. Brewer
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Lola Hunt
 all my rights of ~~dower~~ ^{curtesy} and homestead in and to the said lands.
