Warranty Deed

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we W. E. Rohde and Mary E. Rohde
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby given.

do hereby ~~buy~~ ^{buy} grant, ~~sell~~ ^{convey} and convey unto the said J. M. Cline
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

An undivided half interest in the South half 1/2 of the S.E. 1/4 of Section 12, Township 12,
Range 12 East. Also the N.E. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of the S.W. 1/4 of Section 12, Township 12, Range 12
East containing ninety acres more or less.

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. M. Cline and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant 2 with said J. M. Cline that he
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mary E. Rohde wife of the said W. E. Rohde
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. M. Cline
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
