WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know All Men By These Presents:

do hereby ^{begin} bargain, grant, ^{begin} sell and convey unto the said Mark E. Leavelle
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Cherokee Nation,
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

To have and to hold the same unto the said Mark W. Carr and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant § with said Mark E. Carr that I
will forever warrant and defend the title ^{to} said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, _____, wife of the said _____,
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said _____
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
