Know All Men By These Presents:

That we W. L. Kinnaman and Mary E. Kinnaman
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred & Sixty Five ^{no 100} DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby ~~grant~~ ^{convey} grant, sell and convey unto the said William T. E. N. Agnew
and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Lynch & Forsythe Addition to Tulsa, Ind. Ter.
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

All of Lot Eleven (11), Block Twelve (12), in the Lynch and Forsythe Addition to the City of Tulsa, Ind. Ter., and according to the "Recorded Plat" thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said William T. E. N. Agnew and unto their heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said William T. E. N. Agnew that they
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mary E. Kinnaman wife of the said W. L. Kinnaman
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said William T. E. N. Agnew
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
