## Know All Men By These Presents:

The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and to me in hand paid by Mrs. Lula Wilson.

do hereby ~~grant~~ <sup>buy</sup> grant, sell and convey unto the said Mrs. Lula Wilson  
and unto Her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation

Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Six (6) in Block No. 101 in the Hodge addition to the City of Tulsa, Ind. Ter and  
according to the Survey and Plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Mrs. Lula Wilson and unto Her heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mrs. Lula Wilson that He  
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, J. D. M. P. L. C. L. C. D. C. I. wife of the said J. D. M. P. L. C. L. C. D. C. I.  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
