## Know All Men By Those Presents:

That we John O. Mitchell and Alice M. Mitchell  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) DOLLARS,  
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby ~~grant~~ <sup>buy</sup> grant, sell and convey unto the said S. W. Smith, Skiatook Indian Ter.  
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation

Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

lots five (5), six (6), seven (7), eight (8), nine (9), ten (10), eleven (11) and twelve (12), in  
Block six (6) in West Tulsa, Creek Nation, Indian Territory.

To have and to hold the same unto the said S. W. Smith and unto his heirs  
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said S. W. Smith that they  
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Alice M. Mitchell wife of the said John O. Mitchell  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said S. W. Smith  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
