 and unto *his* heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the *City of Tulsa*
 Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Seven (1) Block Two (2) Friend and Gillette addition to the City of
Tulsa Indian Territory according to the recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said *J. M. Wooden* and unto *his* heirs
 and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said *J. M. Wooden* that *we*
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, *Ernest L. Wilson, husband* wife of the said *Carrie M. Wilson*
 for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said *J. M. Wooden*
