Warranty Deed

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we George W. Mowbray, Jr. and Mayme H. Mowbray
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty Two Hundred & Fifty ^{no. 100} DOLLARS,
The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and to us in hand paid by
C. W. Robertson, Sr.

do hereby ~~grant~~ ^{relinquish} grant, sell and convey unto the said C. W. Robertson, Sr.
and unto His heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the City of Tulsa

Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The North Twenty Five Feet of Lot Four (41) and all of Lot Five (51) in Block Twenty (20),
according to the "Official Plat" and "Government Survey" of the said City of Tulsa, Ind. Ter.
This deed is given subject to a mortgage held by S. C. Taylor and Annie Taylor Jones,
"Trustees". The said C. W. Robertson, Sr. assumes and agrees to pay One Thousand Dollars
of said mortgage when it becomes due.

To have and to hold the same unto the said C. W. Robertson, Sr. and unto His heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said C. W. Robertson, Sr. that They
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mayme H. Mowbray wife of the said George W. Mowbray, Jr.
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said C. W. Robertson, Sr.
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
