And hereby covenant with said Ward Green that I will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mary E. Green wife of the said Ward Green  
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ward Green  
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
