Warranty Deed

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we, George C. Priestley and Lulu R. Priestley
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty-five Hundred (\$2500.00) DOLLARS,
to be paid by the Quasso Gas Company, a corporation incorporated under the laws of Indian Territory and having its main
office in the City of Bartlesville, I.T.

do hereby ~~grant~~ ^{convey} grant, sell and convey unto the said Quasso Gas Company
and unto its successors, heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

North-west quarter (NW 1/4) of North-east quarter (NE 1/4) and the South-west quarter (SW 1/4) of North-east of
North-east quarter (NE 1/4) of NE 1/4 of Sec. Thirty (30) Twp. Twenty-one (21) North Range Thirteen (13) East containing
50 acres more or less according to the U.S. Govt. survey thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Quasso Gas Company and unto its successors, heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Quasso Gas Company that we
will forever warrant and defend the title to the ~~of~~ said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lulu R. Priestley wife of the said George C. Priestley
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Quasso Gas Company
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
