WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we George West and Lizzie West
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and no/100 DOLLARS,
the receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and to us paid Robert I. Bridgewater

do hereby ~~grant~~ ^{convey}, grant, sell and convey unto the said Robert I. Bridgewater
and unto His heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Turkey Addition Cherokee Nation
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Nine (9) and the South (S) six feet of Lot Eight (8) Block Four (4) in the Turkey Addition to Tulsa and its
and according to the Recorded Plat "thereof"

To have and to hold the same unto the said Robert I. Bridgewater and unto His heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Robert I. Bridgewater that They
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lizzie West wife of the said George West
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Robert I. Bridgewater
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
