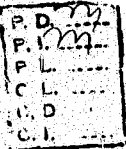

## Know All Men By These Presents:

To have and to hold the same unto the said The Iulsa Title and Trust Company and unto ~~its successors heirs~~  
 and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Iulsa Title & Trust Company that I  
 will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.
