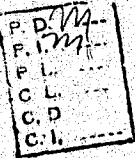

Warranty Deed

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we George M. Janeway and Krances Adelle Janeway
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred Fifty DOLLARS,
to them paid cash in hand, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby ~~grant~~ ^{convey} grant, sell and convey unto the said Harvey W. Hellums
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Cheyenne Nation
Northern District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots Nos One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4) in Block No. Six (6) in Barnett Addition, to the town
of Skistook, Ind. Ter. according to the Plat and Survey thereof (each lot being 25 feet frontage by 140 feet
deep)

To have and to hold the same unto the said Harvey W. Hellums and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Harvey W. Hellums that we
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Krances Adelle Janeway wife of the said George M. Janeway
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Harvey W. Hellums
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
