WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we C. B. Lynch & Jay Forsythe and E. J. Lynch & Jennie Forsythe
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Nine hundred (900.00) DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged in full

do hereby ^{bargain} grant, sell and convey unto the said Edna R. Stahl of Bellview Ohio
and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek Nation
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots One and Two (1 & 2) Block Fifteen (15) and Lots Ten & Eleven (10 & 11) Block
Fourteen (14) Lynch & Forsythe Addition to Tulsa Ind. Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Edna R. Stahl and unto her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant & with said Edna R. Stahl that they
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

it being agreed by Edna R. Stahl in the acceptance of this deed that there is to be no dowering for said Edna R. Stahl

And I, E. J. Lynch wife of the said C. B. Lynch
and Jennie Forsythe wife of the said Jay Forsythe
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Edna R. Stahl
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
