Know All Men By These Presents:

That we, Thomas Wright and Laura Wright
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred DOLLARS,
to be paid by Jefferson M. Gravitt

do hereby ~~grant~~ ^{convey} grant, sell and convey unto the said Jefferson M. Gravitt
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Fourth Recording

Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The S E 1/4 of the S E 1/4 of the N E 1/4 of Section Twenty five (25) Township Twenty (20)
North, Range Fourteen (14) East of the Indian Meridian

To have and to hold the same unto the said Jefferson M. Gravitt and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Jefferson M. Gravitt that we
will forever warrant and defend the title ^{lawful} of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Laura Wright wife ^{and} of the said Thomas Wright
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Jefferson M. Gravitt
all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
