Warranty Deed

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we Lila W. Lindsey and L. W. Lindsey
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred & Twenty Five ^{no. 100} DOLLARS,
the receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged and to us paid by Rebecca Hissong

do hereby ~~grant~~ ^{relinquish} grant, sell and convey unto the said Rebecca Hissong
and unto Her heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the 2nd Lindsey add to Tulsa

Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lot Eleven (11) Block Nine (9) according to the Survey & Plat of said addition to Tulsa, Ind. Ter.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Rebecca Hissong and unto Her heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Rebecca Hissong that They
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, L. W. Lindsey husband ~~of~~ of the said Lila W. Lindsey
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Rebecca Hissong
all my rights of ~~dower~~ ^{contingent} and homestead in and to the said lands.
