WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we Henry Haynes, single, a free citizen, Roll No. 3417

By the Oklahoma Trust Company in cash paid to said Henry Haynes, the Receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged,

do hereby ~~grant~~ ^{convey} and convey unto the said The Oklahoma Trust Company
and unto its heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Western
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South half of the Southeast Quarter (S. 1/2 of the S. E. 1/4) and the Northeast of the Southeast
Quarter (N. E. 1/4 of the S. E. 1/4) of Section Thirty Six (36) Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Fourteen
(14) East of the Indian Meridian

To have and to hold the same unto the said The Oklahoma Trust Company and unto its heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said The Oklahoma Trust Company that he
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I wife of the said
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
