Warranty Deed

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

Know All Men By These Presents:

That we Lorenzo W. Marr and Emily Marr
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred - fifty DOLLARS,
In hand paid by C. K. Parker

do hereby ^{begin} ~~begin~~ grant, sell and convey unto the said C. K. Parker
and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following lands lying in the Creek nation
Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South East quarter of the South West quarter of Section eight (8) Township nineteen (19) North,
Range fourteen (14) East, containing forty acres more or less.

To have and to hold the same unto the said C. K. Parker and unto his heirs
and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said C. K. Parker that we
will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Emily Marr wife of the said Lorenzo W. Marr
for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said C. K. Parker
all my rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
