THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, made and entered into in quadruplicate on this 3rd day of October A.D. 1905 by and between William T. Blakemore, Guardian of Henry Stanley a Mile Miner born January 30th 1901 of Okmusso, Indian Territory party of the first part, and Colin Hil and the Company of Bartlesville Indian Territory, a corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the Indian Territory, and authorized to carry on business in the Indian Territory by compliance with the laws in force therein, party of the second part, and under and in pursuance of the provisions of Section 32 of the Act of Congress approved July 1, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior thereunder.

WITNESSETH: That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the royalties, covenants stipulations and conditions herein after contained and hereby agreed to be full observed and performed by the party of the second part, its successors and assigns, does hereby demise, grant, and let unto the party of the second part, its successors and assigns for the term of fifteen years from the date hereof, and of the oil benefits and natural gas in or
