THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, Made and entered into, in quadruplicate on this 22nd day of September A.J. 1905, by and between Nancy Vann of Stilwell Indian Territory, party of the first part, and Plymouth Oil Company, a corporation, of Bartlesville, Indian Territory, duly organized and existing under the laws in force in the Indian Territory, party of the second part, under and in pursuance of the provisions of Section 72 of the act of Congress approved July 1, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior thereunder.

WITHESSETH: That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the royalties covenants, stipulations, and conditions hereinatter contained and hereby agreed to be paid, observed, and performed by the party of the second part, its successors and assigns, does nereby demise, grant, and letynot the the party of the second part, its successors and assigns for the term of firteen (15) years from the date nereor, all or the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the rollowing described tract of land, lying and being within The North the Chewokee Nation and Within the Indian Territory, to-wit: West Luarter of South West Quarter, and Southwest Cuarter of North East Quarter of South West Quarter of section Twenty (20) stownship twenty one (21) North range Fourteen (14) East, of the Indian Meridian, and containing Fifty (50) acres, more or less, with the right to prospect for, extract, pipe, store refine and remove such oil and natural gas, and to occupy and use so much only of the surface of said land as may be reasonably necessary to carry on the work of prospecting for, extracting; piping, for storing, refining, and removing such oil and natural gas, including also the right to obtain from wells or other sources on said land, by means of pipe lines or otherwise a sufficient supply of fuel so far as it is necessary to the prosecution of said operations.
