OIL AND GAS MINING LEASE.

UPON LANDS SELECTED FOR ALLOTMENT, CHEROKEE NATION, INDIAN TERRITORY.
(Section 72 Act of July 1, 1902, 32 Stat. 716, 726)

THIS INDENTURE OF LEASE, made and entered into, in quadruplicate, on this 21st day of October A.D. 1905, by and between Chas. V. McGaw, of Owasso, Indian Territory, Guardian of Harvey Ketcher of Owasso, Indian Territory, party of the first part, and Plymouth Oil Company, a corporation of Bartlesville, Indian Territory, duly organized and existing under the laws in force in the Indian Territory, party of the second part, under and in pursuance of the provisions of section 72 of the act of Congress approved July 1, 1902, and the regulations prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior thereunder.

WITNESSETH: That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the royalties, covenants, stipulations, and conditions hereinafter contained, and hereby agreed to be paid, observed, and performed by the party of the second part, its successors and assigns, does hereby demise, grant, and let unto the party of the second part, its successors and assigns for the term of ten Years Five Months and Ten Days from the date hereof, all of the oil deposits and natural gas in or under the following described tract of land lying and being within the Cherokee Nation and within the Indian Territory, to-wit: The W2 of NW4 or SE4; W2 of NE4 or SE4 less 288 acres *2 1/2 of NW4 of SE4 less 246 acres for Kansas Oklahoma Central and Southwestern Railroad Right of way* section twenty four (24) Township Twenty one (21) North, range Thirteen (13) East, of the Indian Meridian, and containing Sixty (60) acres more or less, with the right to prospect for, extract, pipe, store, refine, and remove such oil and natural gas, and to occupy and use so much only of the surface or said land as may be reasonably necessary to carry on the work of prospecting for, extracting, piping, storing, refining, and removing such oil and natural gas, including the right to obtain from wells or other sources on said land, by means of pipe lines or otherwise a sufficient supply of water to carry on said operations, and including still further the right to use such oil and natural gas as fuel so far as it is necessary
