Coad Jr. of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and sold and by these presents do grant and convey unto the said party of the second part, his executors, administrators and assigns all personal property belonging to them and used for mining purposes on the Brady Coal Lease in Tulsa County State of Oklahoma, together with the commissary owned by them, and which personal property among others is described as follows.
