Range 13 E. said brick plant corner being the Northeast corner of said Section 36 Township 26 N. Range 15 E; thence in a generally southwesterly direction and having an interior diameter of 12 inches a distance of about 12000 feet, to a point; thence in a generally Southwesterly direction and having an interior diameter of 8 inches about 5,000 feet to a point; thence in a generally southwesterly direction and having an interior diameter of 6 inches about 59864 feet to a point, said point being at or near the Northeast corner of the Annie Hummingbird Allotment in Section 18, Township 24 N. Range 14 E., Washington County, Oklahoma, described as follows: $\frac{W}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ containing 100 acres more or less.
