Also a certain contract entered into by and between The Henry Oil Company, a corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Dakota, and The Citizens Gas Company of Nowata, dated December 21st, 1906, recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Washington County, Oklahoma, in Book O Page 120 on the-----day of December, 1906; also recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds of Nowata County, Oklahoma, in Record Book 3 Page 76, now destroyed by fire, hereby referred to and made a part hereof.

Also a certain contract, together with the income and proceeds therefrom entered into by and between the Citizens Gas Company and G.R. Hemminger, dated the 5th day of November, 1909, and recorded in the office of Register of Deeds of Nowata County, Oklahoma, on the----day of November, and in the office of the Register of Deeds of Washington County, Oklahoma, November----1909, and in the office of the Register of Deeds of Rogers County, Oklahoma, November-----, 1909, and in the office of the Register of Deeds of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, November----, 1909, hereby referred to and made a part hereof.)

And the party of the first part doth hereby warrant the title to the same unto the said G.R. Hemminger, his successors and assigns, free and clear of all encumbrances, except a mortgage in the sum of forty five Thousand (\$45,000.00) Dollars given to secure an issue of bonds in favor of J.E. Campbell, of Nowata, Oklahoma.

This mortgage is given to secure the principal sum of Forty Thousand (\$40,000.00) dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of six (6%) per cent per annum, payable annually from date, according to the tenure of one certain promissory note described as follows, and made a part hereof, to-wit:

Nowata, Oklahoma, November----1909.

Four years after date hereof for value received, The Citizens Gas Company of Nowata, Oklahoma, hereby promises to pay to the order of G.R. Hemminger, the principal sum of Forty Thousand (\$40,000.00) Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, with interest thereon at the rate of six (6%) per cent per annum, payable annually on the----day of November, in each year, according to the tenor of all four of the annexed interest coupons for twenty-four Hundred (\$2400.00) Dollars each, bearing even date herewith.

Both principal and interest of the notes, payable at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and if any interest coupon or any part thereof is not paid when due or in case of failure to comply with any requirements of the mortgage given by the maker hereof to secure the payment of this note, the principal and accrued interest shall become due and payable at once at the option of the legal holder of this note.
