

to immediate possession of the land.

If, at any time, the Secretary of the Interior, after due notice to the parties interested, determines that any person, partnership, or corporation has, by means of stock ownership, or otherwise, directly or indirectly, obtained and holds interests in leases of oil and gas properties in said territory, said leases covering, in the aggregate, an area of more than 4,800 acres, and further finds that the property herein leased is a part of said aggregate area; then the Secretary of the Interior may cancel this lease in the same manner as provided for in the case of any violation of the terms of said lease.

It is further agreed and understood that the approval of this lease shall be of no force or effect, unless the parties of the second part furnish within sixty days from the date of approval of the application filed in connection herewith, a bond to the satisfaction of the Secretary of the Interior, in accordance with the regulations of March 220, 1905, prescribed by the Secretary of the Interior, which shall be deposited and remain on file in the Indian Office during the life of this lease.
