premises and the lessors to have has tree of cost at their own risk for one dwelling house on said premises, during the same time, to be used economically.

Third. The lessee agrees to complete a well on said premises within three years from date hereof, or pay ten dollars her year for each additional year completion is delayed from the time above mentioned for completing of such well until a well is completed.

Fourth. The lessee further agreed to bury pipe lines for oil in cultivated fields below plow depth when requested to do so by lessor, and to pay for damage done growing crops while drilling.

Fifth. The lesses agree not to drill any wells within 250 feet of any buildings on said remises without the written consent of the lessors. FURTHERMORE, the lessors hereby release and waive all rights under and by virtue or the homestead exemption laws or this state as they may effect said premises. And the lessors also consent to the lessee selling or disposing of said lease.

FURTHERMORE, it is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto that the lessee shall have the right to use gas, oil and water produced on said land for his operations thereon or other lands near lease except water from the wells or lessors.

And All money accruing to lessor under this contract may be raid by check or cash direct to any one or the lessor or mailed to J. Robert Gillam at Ardmore, Oklahoma, or payment may be made through Guarranty State Bank, Ardmore. Oklahoma.

It is agreed that all the terms and conditions hereor shall extend and apply to the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the parties hereto.
