#### RENTAL CONTRACT

COMPARED

THIS AGREEMENT, Made and entered into this 20th day of November 1909 by and between Sarah Fields, guardian of Willie Grayson, a minor, of Haskell, Okla. party of the first part, and Louis Pregler, of Leonard, Okla. party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements hereinafter made the party of the first part has let, leased and demised and does by these presents let, lease and demise unto the party of the second part for agricultural purposes for the term of five years from and after the 1st day of January 1910 the following described tracts of land lying in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma:

W.  $\frac{1}{2}$  or the S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  section 14, Township 17 North, Range 14 East containing 80 acres more or less.

The party of the second part, for the use of the said land, agrees to pay to the party of the first part as rent, seventy five a-----00/100 Dollars, per annum during the term of this contract, payable as follows: \$61.00 in cash and \$14.00 worth of posts at 4¢ each, Dec. 1, 1910, and \$75.00 in cash on the first day of December of each succeeding year during the term of this contract.
