GUARDIAN'S DEED.

COMPARED

THIS INDENTURE, Made the 29th day of November nineteen hundred and nine at Broken Arrow, Okla. State of Oklahoma, by and between E.E. Cooper the duly appointed qualified and acting Guardian of Stella Cooper, Florence Cooper, Lizzie Haynes and Lydia Haynes, minors party of the first part, and F.S. Hurd the party of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That whereas, on the 11th day of November 1908, the County Court, within and for the County of Tulsa. State of Oklahoma, rade an order of Sale, authorizing the said arty of the first part to sell certain real estate of the said minors situated in the County of Tulsa and other lands in State of Oklahoma, described in said Order of Sale.

And Thereas, under end by virtue or said Order or Sale, and pursuant to legal notices given thereof, the said party of the first part, on the 2nd day of February A.D. nineteen hundred and nine sold the hereinafter described real estate specified and described in said Order of Sale, subject to confirmation by said court, for the sum of Thirteen Hundred twelve & 50/100 dollars to F. S. Hurd he-- being the highest and best bidder and that being the highest and best sum bid.

Cooper as the Guardian or the said Stella Cooper, Florence Cooper, Lizzia Haynes and Lydia Haynes, minors, as aforesaid, the party of the first part, pursuant to the order last aforesaid of the said county court, and for the consideration or the sum of Inirteen Rundred Ewelve and 50/100 dollars to him in hand raid by the said arty of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever all the right, title, interest and estate or the said Stella Cooper, Plorence Cooper, Lizzie Haynes and Lydia Haynes, in and to all the certain lot, piece or parcel or land situated lying and being in said "ounty or Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, and bounded and particularly described as follows, to-wit:
