321 CREEK Nation, for the removal of the restrictions upon the alienation of her allotment (except her homestead), and am, as the result of that investigation satisfied that the removal of restrictions upon the alienation of her allotted lands, except as to her homestead, will be for the best interests of the allottee, and I so recommend.
