CONTRACT

This Contract made and entered into this date the thirteenth day of November, 1909, by and between the Mohawk Mining Co. party of the first part and Alex. S. Lewis party of the second part.

And it is further understood that the party of the first part the Mohawk Mining Co. agrees to mine coal from the slope that John Calvert was operating, now the property of Alex. S. Lewis. The party of the first part to operate the mine in a workman like mining manner, the party of the first part having authority to mine coal on the old W.W. Williams land which was lately sold to some other parties but on which land Alex. S. Lewis holds the coal lease and also on Alex. S. Lewis land.

For which the party of the first part agree to pay party of the second part Alex. S. Lewis a royalty of twelve and one half cents per ton of 2000 pounds. Said royalty to be paid on the tenth of each month, for all coal mined in the preceeding month.

Party of the second part hereby give to the party of the first part a lease of four months from date of this contract on said above described lands And also gives to the party of the first part the option or renewing this present four months lease, to a five years lease.

In case the party of the first part will not enter into the five years lease at the expiration of this first four months lease, then this mine to be returned to the party of the second part all well timbered, up, the mine pumped out and all pillars left in the mine.
