CONFIRMATION ORDER.

Now on this 28th day of November, 1909, there coming on for hearing the return of sale of oil and gas leases made by Frank Wolfe as the Guardian of the estate of Mabel A. and Leona Marie Wolfe, minors and said minors appearing by their guardian, Frank Wolfe, and the Court having examined said return, and having heard and considered the evidence of witnesses offered in support of said return and being fully advised in the premises, finds:

That in pursuance of said order of sale, said Frank Wolfe on the 19th day of November, 1909, sold oil and gas leases on the real estate of said minors, described as follows: to-wit:

Mabel A. Wolfe.

SW/4 of NW/4 and 1/2 of SE/4 of NW/4 and SE/4 of NE/4 or SE/4 of Section 22, Township 20 North Range 14 East, containing 70 acres, more or less, being the allotment of Mabel A. Wolfe, a minor.

Leona Marie Wolfe;

NE/4 of SE/4 and 3/2 of NW/4 of SE/4 Section 17; and SW/4 of NE/4 or N SE/4 of Section 22, all in Township 20 North Range 14 East, being the allotment of Leona Marie Wolfe, a minor, and containing 70 acres, more or less. at private sale to Lucas Oil Company, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, a corporation upon the following terms to-wit:

For the sum of Three (3.00) Dollars per acre bonus, and a rental together with a one-eighth (1/8) royalty for the oil and valuable gas royalty.
